Employment Opportunity:

The San Mateo County Mosquito and Vector District is accepting applications for a qualified individual interested in a career as a Mosquito Control Technician. Applicant must be able to work independently out of doors, under varied climatic conditions, and through technical training obtain State Certification in mosquito and/or other vector-related disciplines within 2 years of employment.

Position: Mosquito Control Technician **Salary Range:** \$24.10 – \$32.89 per hour

Description:

Under supervision, perform inspections and control operations for mosquitoes and other vectors; duties include field and lab work, mapping, data gathering, record keeping, environmental management, and working daily with the public. Also, do related work and supportive services as required.

Minimum Requirements:

Oral skills to communicate the District's mosquito control program with the public; math skills to calculate pesticide applications including multiplication, division of whole numbers, percentages, fractions, and conversion of units of measure; writing skills to clearly and neatly fill out forms and reports; reading skills to understand English composition as used in maintenance and training manuals; minimum education equivalent to or graduation from high school; must have, or be able to obtain a valid California driver's license within three (3) days of employment; be insurable under the guidelines of the Vector Control Joint Powers Agency; proof of employment eligibility in the United States, and pass a pre-employment medical examination, if offered the position.

Physical Characteristics:

Work requires physical labor and use of machinery performing skilled or semi-skilled operations; visual acuity to locate immature mosquitoes in water and read fine print; hear and speak well enough to converse in person or on two-way radio or telephone; body movement or mobility to walk in 2' - 3' of water, on uneven terrain, cracked ground, pickle weed marshes; climb in and out of vehicles and up embankments such as creek sides; use of hands and fingers to operate spray equipment, hand tools, power equipment and write reports; strength to individually carry a (5) gallon back pack sprayer weighing up to 50 lbs. during hot weather approaching (100°F); stamina to walk in and along creeks, ditches and marshes for up to 7 hours a day; and physical tolerance to work under adverse conditions such as heat of (100°F) or cold of (30°F) and during rain.
